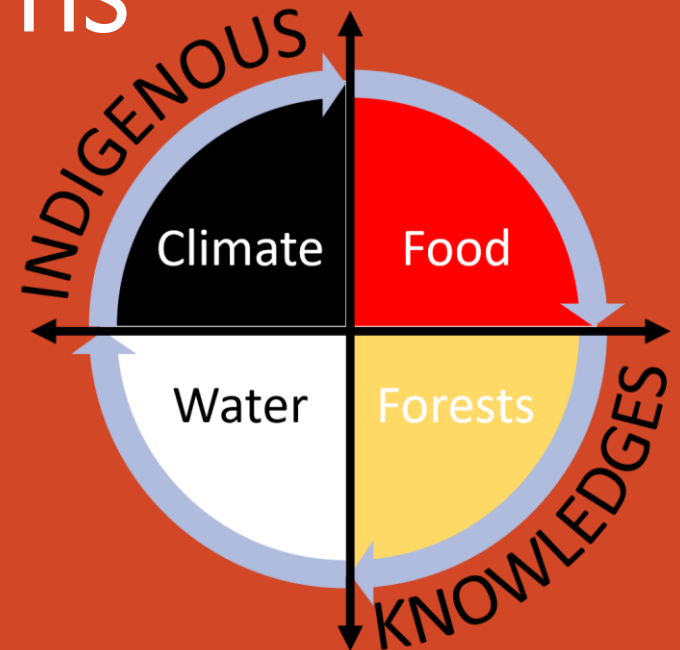

Grey areas represent the regional network of 60 ATNI member tribal reservations in WA, OR, ID, NV and CA. SE Alaska tribes not pictured.

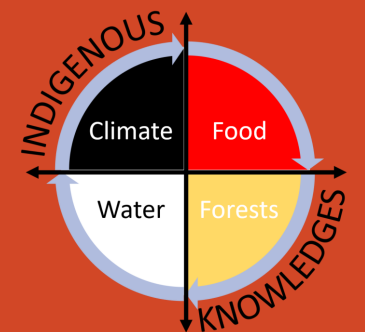
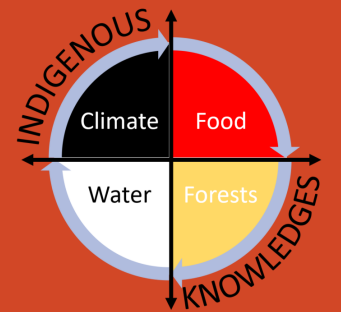

Indigenous Values Statement:

In our Indigenous communities, knowledge is shared as a gift; this gift must be honored and shared with respect and in the manner it was gifted.

Indigenous knowledge is often specific to the tribe, band, or geographic region in which it originates, and for this reason, it is sometimes shared only within these groups. To honor our Ancestors and knowledge carriers, and to protect our cultural ways and resources, we must make sure access to the knowledge aligns with our values and is appropriate to be taught in your community, classroom, and region.
