Overview



This document outlines *Food-Fueled*'s artificial intelligence (AI) best practices that students wishing to submit to the journal must adhere to. Unless stated otherwise, these guidelines apply regardless of submission type, genre, or category. Appropriate Use



Food-Fueled recognizes the great research potential that can be realized through AI use. However, the erosion of original work and ideas along with the massive environmental impact of AI overuse causes concern. Food-Fueled has decided to encourage the use of AI **only as a data analytics tool**. Editors will not accept submissions determined to be created by, in part or in whole, generative AI, including ChatGPT, Copilot, Gemini, DeepSeek, and others. If a student is found to have used generative AI on a submitted piece, their piece will not be published in that year's edition of Food-Fueled, and they may be barred from submitting to the journal in the future.

Conversely, Food-Fueled is also aware of the immense value that studying AI/AI models can bring to a variety of disciplines. Students wishing to submit papers on AI-related research should do so without fear of being penalized for their submission's topic.

**Determinations will be made at the editors' discretion and may include the use of AI Writing Detectors.*
